

Instructions

For Copying Into Column:

Print & cut out image then place behind page column. Hold in place with washi tape. Simply trace over the image as you like with your micron pen, or pen of your choice.

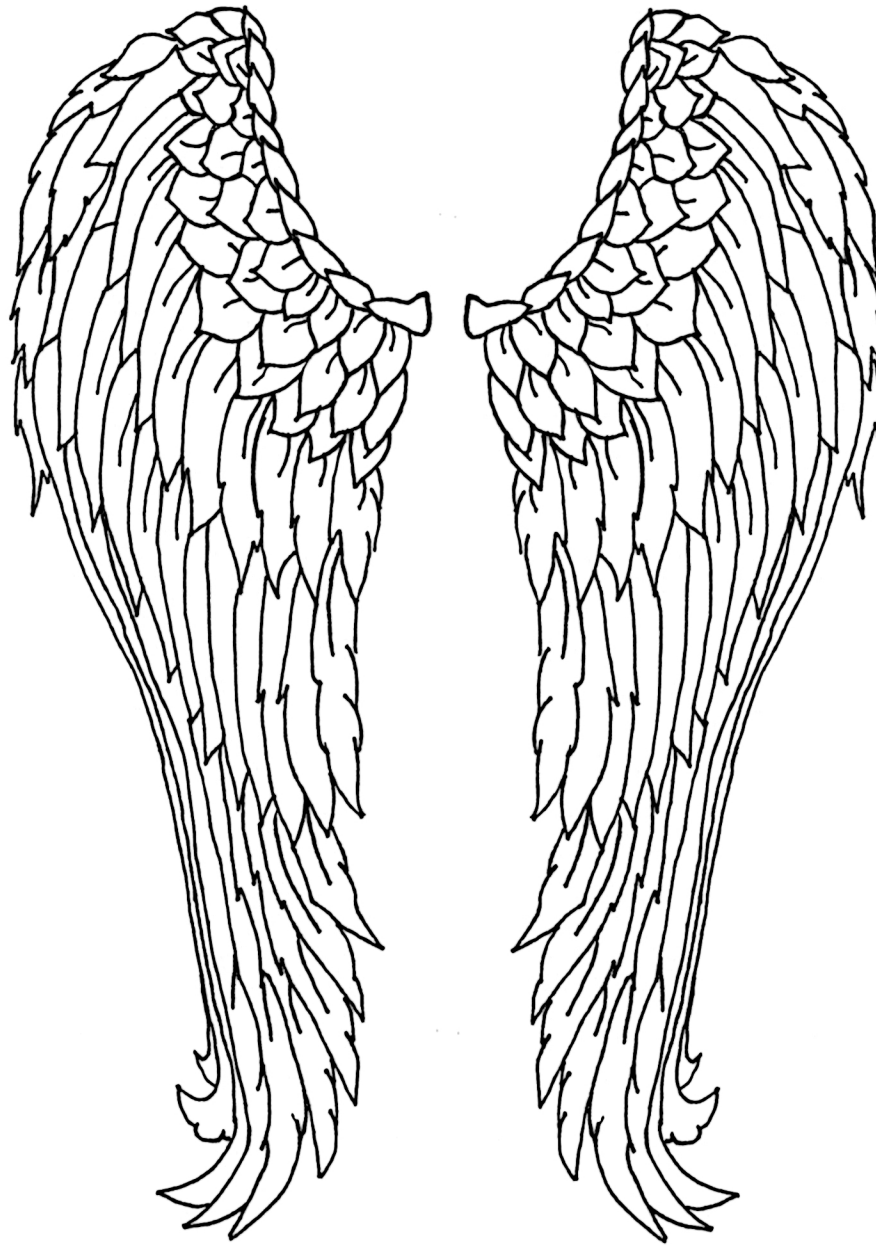
For Copying Onto Full Page:

If you want to doodle on the whole page you will need graphite paper to transfer the images b/c it is a bit difficult to see through the print on your bible page.

1. Place the graphite paper face down on your page.
2. Place the image you want to transfer face up on your page (or face down if you want to flip your image).
3. Trace your image with a pen (a ball point pen works well).
4. Remove your papers and save your graphite paper to use again on another project.
5. With your micron pen, draw over your graphite markings in your Bible. Then lightly erase them.
6. Color your image as you wish!

Note:

If you plan to use a medium like watercolor I recommend preparing your surface with Gesso or Matte Medium Gel. Just a thin layer is all you need. Apply w/a makeup sponge wedge for a smooth texture or use your fingers for a more bumpy texture. The Gel dries clear. The Gesso, if you apply thin enough you will still be able to read the words of your Bible. You can also buy clear Gesso.
